The total weight of the locomotive was 100 tons and is 60 feet long. The truck and trailer that brought her here was 225 feet long. The trailer had 96-wheels under it.




Sher is an RSD-4. There were only 36 made and she is the sole survivor. She competes our collection, we have a RS-2 and a RS-3 too.
