NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Addendum is part of the Original Request for Proposal (RFP).

The following shall be changed as part of the Original Request for Proposal (RFP).

- 1. The Request for Proposal shall be updated as follows:
 - EXTENSION: All proposals must be received by the City Clerk's Office, 501 Mill Street, Ely, Nevada 89301 by June 18, 2025, no later than 3:00 pm Pacific Time. Proposals received after the established deadline will be returned to the Offeror and will not receive any consideration in the evaluation process. Submitted proposals will be opened at City Hall immediately after the published deadline for acceptance of said proposals. Pursuant to NRS 333.3335(7), each submitted proposal is confidential and may not be disclosed until the contract is awarded by the Ely City Council.
 - **CLARIFICATIONS:** 1. City Hall Fiber DIA is 500 MBPs, from which its Wastewater Treatment Plant has PTP 250 Mbps. 2. Class II cables do not need to be in conduit, per City of Ely Building Department. 3. The White Pine County Sheriff's Office, who the City of Ely contracts with for Police Protection Services, does not require on-site data storage. All cloud storage must be kept in a secured facility/manner with password protection access only; it should also have an audit trail. 4. License plate capture is a requirement of the system, with a storage database. 5. Expected image quality at 300 feet is sufficient to identify subjects. 6. The City of Ely is primarily looking for a reactive security camera solution. 7. Monitoring, using the new security camera system, will be provided by the City of Ely and White Pine County Sheriff's Office. 8. AI Analytics is not required, but the City of Ely is open to Al Analytics features and/or options. 9. The City of Ely does not require the service firm to provide wireless data to a central location. 10. Wireless data transmission is not in place for every camera installation site; this will need to be a part of the proposal from each interested party, including provision and installation of network switches and needed network racks/patch panels/UPS power. 11. The City of Ely is open to considering one-time licensing costs or yearly licensing fees.
