





Dear Mr. Samberg:

This letter is to confirm our understanding of the terms and objectives of our Engagement and the nature and limitations of the services we will provide.

We will perform the following agreed upon services relating to the matter between the City of Ely and White Pine Railroad Foundation, Inc. vs. S&S Shortline Leasing, LLC:

1. Serve as an expert witness for the City of Ely;
2. Determine whether S&S Shortline Leasing, LLC fulfilled its obligations as spelled out in the Lease Agreement/Joint Development Agreement between the above named parties and dated July 31, 2009;
3. Determine whether S&S Shortline Leasing, LLC provided an accounting of any expenses incurred for rehabilitation and maintenance on at least a quarterly basis from the beginning of the agreement referenced above;
4. Determine amounts, if any, owing to the City of Ely from S&S Shortline Leasing, LLC;
5. Prepare an opinion in a written report based on our findings

These services will be performed in accordance with applicable professional standards issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

This Engagement is limited to the examination services outlined above. Larry L. Bertsch, CPA & Associates, LLP, in its sole professional judgment, reserves the right to refuse to take any action that could be construed as making management decisions or performing management functions.

In order for us to complete this Engagement, and to do so efficiently, we require unrestricted access to the financial information that you possess. Any failure to provide such documents and information, and to do so on a timely basis, will impede our services, and may require us to suspend our services or withdraw from the Engagement.

Prior to commencing our services, we require that you provide us with a retainer in the amount of \$10,000.00. The retainer will be applied against our final invoice, and any unused portion will be returned to you upon collection of all outstanding fees and costs related to this Engagement. We bill for our work at an hourly rate between \$75.00 and \$250.00 per hour depending upon the scope of the work and the staff assigned in addition to any expenses incurred during the engagement.

In the event that any collection action is required to collect unpaid balances due us, you agree to reimburse us for our costs of collection, including attorney's fees. If we elect to terminate our services for nonpayment, or for any other reason provided for in this letter, our Engagement will be deemed to have been completed upon written notification of termination, even if we have not completed our report. You will be obligated to compensate us through the date of termination.

In connection with this Engagement, we may communicate with you or others via email transmission. As emails can be intercepted and read, disclosed, or otherwise used or communicated by an unintended third party, or may not be delivered to each of the parties to whom they are directed and only to such party, we cannot guarantee or warrant that emails from us will be properly delivered and read only by the addressee. Therefore, we specifically disclaim and waive any liability or responsibility whatsoever for interception or unintentional disclosure of emails transmitted by us in connection with the performance of the Engagement. In that regard, you agree that we shall have no liability for any loss or damage to any person or entity resulting from the use of email transmissions, including any consequential, incidental, direct, indirect, or special damages, such as loss of revenues or anticipated profits, or disclosure or communication of confidential or proprietary information.

It is our policy to retain Engagement documentation for a period of seven years, after which time we will commence the process of destroying the contents of our Engagement files. To the extent, we accumulate any of your original records during the Engagement, those documents will be returned to you promptly upon completion of the Engagement, and you will provide us with a receipt for the return of such records. The balance of our Engagement file, which we will provide to you at the conclusion of the Engagement, is our property, and we will provide copies of such documents at our discretion and if compensated for any time and costs associated with the effort.

In the event we are required to respond to a subpoena, court order or other legal process for the production of documents and/or testimony relative to information we obtained and/or prepared during the course of this Engagement, you agree to compensate us at our standard hourly rates then existing for the time we expend in connection with such response, and to reimburse us for all of our out-of-pocket costs incurred in that regard.

Any mediation initiated because of the Engagement shall be administered within Clark County, Nevada, by JAMS, according to its mediation rules, and any ensuing litigation shall be conducted within said county, according to Nevada law. The results of any such mediation shall be binding only upon agreement for each party to be bound. The participating parties shall share the costs of any mediation proceeding (other than professional fees incurred by each party) equally.

Any litigation arising out of this Engagement, except actions by us to enforce payment of our professional invoices, must be asserted within one year from the date any such cause of action accrues, or within three years from the completion of the Engagement, whichever is earlier, notwithstanding any statutory provision to the contrary. In the event of litigation brought against us, any judgment you obtain shall be limited in amount, and shall not exceed the amount of the fee charged by us, and paid by you, for the services set forth in this Engagement letter.

In the absence of any other written communications from us documenting additional services, our services will be limited to and governed by the terms of this Engagement letter.

You also acknowledge that we, in the course of our work, may view or otherwise come into contact with information you consider confidential. In such case, we undertake to keep such information confidential subject to governing law, jurisprudence and/or order of a court of competent jurisdiction and you agree that no action can be taken against Larry L. Bertsch, CPA & Associates, LLP as a result of our view or contact with the confidential information unless we fail to honor your undertaking as defined in this paragraph.

This Engagement letter is contractual in nature, and includes all of the relevant terms that will govern the Engagement for which it has been prepared. The terms of this letter supersede any prior oral or written representations or commitments by or between the parties. Any material changes or additions to the terms set forth in this letter will only become effective if evidenced by a written amendment to this letter, signed by all parties. 2 **FOR POLICE PROTECTION**

3 The County of White Pine, State of Nevada, by and through its Board of County
4 Commissioners ("County"), the City of Ely, an incorporated City in the County of White Pine,
5 State of Nevada, by and through its Mayor and City Council ("City"), and Scott Henriod, Sheriff
6 of White Pine County, hereby mutually agree to modify the July 22, 2015, Interlocal Agreement
7 for Police Protection ("Agreement"), as follows.

9 WHEREAS, NRS 277.180(1) allows public agencies to contract with other public agencies to

EXHIBIT B

MODIFIED PAYMENT SCHEDULE/CALCULATIONS

1. **Calculation Methodology.** Beginning July 1, 2018, the Parties agree that the method of calculation of the City's contributions shall be completed in the following manner.
 - a. **City's total revenues:** The Parties agree to always look back two years to the City's audited financial record to determine the City's general fund revenues. For example, to calculate the required payment for 2015-2016, the parties will look at the City's 2013-2014 audited financial report for the total general fund revenue.
 - b. **Formula:** The Parties will insert the City's general fund revenue in the following formula: total general fund revenue, minus all grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services provided to the County by the City, multiplied by the appropriate fiscal year's percentage, as outlined below.
 - c. **Percentage Applied:**
 - I. Effective July 1, 2018, the percentage of total general fund revenues of Fiscal Year 2016-2017 audited general fund revenue excluding grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services provided to the County by the City, to be paid to the County for comprehensive police services shall be 25.0%.
 - II. Effective July 1, 2019, the percentage of total general fund revenues of Fiscal Year 2017-2018 audited general fund revenue excluding grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services provided to the County by the City, to be paid to the County for comprehensive police services shall be 26.0%.
 - III. Effective July 1, 2020, the percentage of total general fund revenues of Fiscal Year 2018-2019 audited general fund revenue excluding grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services provided to the County by the City, to be paid to the County for comprehensive police services shall be 27.0%.
 - IV. Effective July 1, 2021, the percentage of total general fund revenues of Fiscal Year 2019-2020 audited general fund revenue excluding grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services

provided to the County by the City, to be paid to the County for comprehensive police services shall be 27.0%.

V. Effective July 1, 2022, the percentage of total general fund revenues of Fiscal Year 2020-2021 audited general fund revenue excluding grant revenue and revenue paid by the County to the City for contracted services provided to the County by the City, to be paid to the County for comprehensive police services shall be 27.0%.

2. **Minimum Payment.** The Parties agree that the minimum annual payment due, beginning July 1, 2015, and for the term of this Agreement shall not fall below \$450,000.00, during any one fiscal year. Therefore, in applying the formula, if the amount owed based on the formulas provided herein were to be less than \$450,000, then the City would be liable to pay the minimum of \$450,000.00 for that fiscal year.
3. **Maximum Payment.** The Parties agree that the maximum payment due, beginning July 1, 2015, and for the term of this Agreement shall never exceed \$750,000.00, during any one fiscal year. Therefore, in applying the formula, if the amount owed based on the formulas provided herein was greater than \$750,000.00, then the City would only be liable to pay the maximum of \$750,000.00 for that fiscal year.






5. Ridership and Ticket Sales – Updated

6. Paint the Railroad Red Week




Total Ridership


1987 - 2018


